

What you will need to know about the reopening of Holy Rosary Church for masses.

Due to the restrictions on personal space, our seating capacity will be reduced. Once we have reached what we have determined is an acceptable number inside the church, with sufficient distancing, we will be required to turn people away.

Please be mindful of this when deciding if you should come to mass.

When arriving at mass people are required to remain outside the sanctuary (maybe even outside) before an usher will come and seat them.

Families may be seated together as a unit by the ushers, provided the 6 foot spacing between your family and others is maintained.

- Doors will open 30 minutes before mass begins.
- We encourage those who can to wear masks, for the safety of those around them.
- Each person will sanitize their hands (provided at the church) and pick up a disposable liturgy sheet.
- Holy water will not be available.
- While we will not be praying the Rosary together before mass, you are encouraged to pray silently once you are seated and waiting for mass to begin.
- Collection baskets will not be passed. You may continue giving online, or you can place your offering in the baskets that will be provided at the doors.
- The sign of peace is omitted.
- Distribution of the Body of Christ is to be offered in the hand only.
- Communion is optional; those desiring to receive the Eucharist will proceed single file, 6 feet apart down each aisle.
- When exiting the church, the liturgy sheets will be discarded in the bins provided. Please use the hand sanitizer again before leaving.
- No social gatherings are allowed in the church and if you wish to socialize it should be at a safe distance (6 feet apart) outside of the church.

What you will need to know about coming for Saturday confessions at Holy Rosary Church.

- Doors will open at 3:15 pm on Saturdays with Confessions beginning at 3:30 pm.
- The only entrance and exit for confessions will be from the Main Street doors.
- The line for confessions will be in the entryway and not inside the sanctuary.
- Father will be seated at the back of the confessional and you will be seated or kneeling at a safe distance.
- A limited number of pews will be reserved at the back for personal prayer after confession. You will NOT be free to roam around the sanctuary or have access to the chapel.
- The only restrooms that will be accessible will be the ones closest to the Main Street entrance.
